Broken into three units of learning, each unit will explore a different facet of working as a counselor at our summer dance camp. Campers can earn a program certificate by completing each of the C.I.T. units twice. Taking each unit twice enables campers to delve deeper into the material and learn all the ins and outs of being a camp counselor. The second year a C.I.T. takes a unit they will have new assignments and take on more responsibility. Our goal is to prepare them for volunteer work or employment in a camp setting. We recommend new C.I.T. campers start with Unit 1 if possible. Units may be done all in one summer, or over the course of a few years. C.I.T. campers will work both behind the scenes as well as hands on with campers in addition to completing their C.I.T. assignments and projects. JMD C.I.T. graduates will have future opportunities to work as volunteers within JMD Camps and can even progress to a Jr. Counselor where tuition credit for JMD Classes can be earned. We also hope to hire future Camp Counselors from our C.I.T. program once they are 16 years of age or older. How quickly each C.I.T. works through the program and can move up to each level will be assessed individually based on maturity, grasp of materials, participation, and interaction with campers. The CIT program is a work-study program and CIT's receive reduced camp tuition under this premise, therefore all C.I.T.'s should be prepared to serve as leaders.

### **UNIT 1: CAMP & CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT SKILLS – Week of July 11<sup>th</sup> & Week of August 1<sup>st</sup>.**
